BEGINNERS

The beginner tennis player will learn the rules of the game, how to hold the racquet, basic ground strokes, and how to serve. Emphasizing the fundamentals of tennis while having fun at the same time, players enrolled in the “beginner” program have had little or no tennis instruction.
