



SWIMMING POOL RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Season swipe cards are not transferable. Swipe cards must be shown and used each visit or pay regular admission.
2. Children who cannot walk will not be charged when accompanied by an adult paying general admission.
3. Adults 18 and older may use the Spectator fee when accompanying a patron paying the General Admission Fee.
4. Children under the age of 10 should be accompanied by an adult.
5. No Refunds or Rain Checks will be given.
6. No outside, food, beverages, and coolers are permitted in the MARC Facility.
7. No Glass Containers in the Pool Area.
8. Absolutely NO ALCOHOL or ILLEGAL DRUGS permitted in the Recreation Complex /or grounds.
9. Use of the pools by persons under the influence of alcohol or drugs is prohibited.
10. No tobacco products in facilities including outside Pool areas.
11. The pool will close when the outdoor temperature falls below 65 degrees Fahrenheit or when lightning or other threatening weather exists. We use Armstrong cable channel 36
12. No running, pushing, or horseplay permitted in the pool area.
13. Proper swim attire must be worn.
14. All life jackets must be U.S. Coast Guard approved and an adult must be in the pool within arm's reach of the child. NO INFLATABLE WATER WINGS ALLOWED.
15. Swimmers must shower after using sandy volleyball courts. (Use shower outside main pool towards volleyball courts.)
16. Diving permitted in deep well only.
17. Use caution when diving to avoid head and neck injuries.
18. Diving board fulcrum will be kept forward for all recreational swimming sessions. (No exceptions)
19. The staff and all rules and regulations of the Meadville Area Recreation Authority MUST BE OBEYED AT ALL TIMES.
20. If a guard feels an action is not safe, he/or she may make a ruling to not permit it to continue.
21. Lewd, profane, or abusive language and/or actions will not be tolerated. Please respect the rights of others.

22. It is expected that all swimmers and patrons treat the properties of the Meadville Area Recreation Complex with due respect and be financially responsible for all damages. Please respect the rights of others.
23. No urinating or defecating in the pools.
24. No pets in the pool area except for Service Animals.
25. Do not use the pools if you are ill with diarrhea or have a communicable disease
26. Persons with contagious or infectious health conditions are not permitted to patronize the pools.
27. The management has the right to ask patrons to leave for non-compliance with the above rules.

All rules above are to insure that the MARC remains a safe, fun place for Health and Wellness to flourish. Please be considerate of other patrons and our staff during your use here as we wish everyone has the same wonderful experience!
